- A. **Academic Achievement** means the student's performance on standardized tests and other measures of academic achievement.
- B. **Academic Progress** means the student's progress in meeting the standards of academic achievement.
- C. **Academic Review** means the process of reviewing a student's academic performance and determining whether the student is eligible for promotion.
- D. **Academic Standing** means the student's status in terms of academic achievement and progress.
- E. **Academic Success** means the student's achievement of the standards of academic achievement.
- F. **Academic Warning** means the student's status in terms of academic achievement and progress, which is less than satisfactory.
- G. **Academic Year** means the period of time during which the student is enrolled in school.
- H. **Academic Year Review** means the process of reviewing a student's academic performance at the end of the academic year.
- I. **Academic Year Review Committee** means the committee responsible for reviewing a student's academic performance at the end of the academic year.
- J. **Academic Year Review Committee Chair** means the member of the committee who is responsible for chairing the committee.
- K. **Academic Year Review Committee Member** means a member of the committee responsible for reviewing a student's academic performance at the end of the academic year.
- L. **Academic Year Review Committee Secretary** means the member of the committee who is responsible for recording the minutes of the committee.
- M. **Academic Year Review Committee Vice Chair** means the member of the committee who is responsible for acting as the chair in the absence of the chair.
- N. **Academic Year Review Committee Vice Secretary** means the member of the committee who is responsible for acting as the secretary in the absence of the secretary.
- O. **Academic Year Review Committee Vice Vice Chair** means the member of the committee who is responsible for acting as the vice chair in the absence of the vice chair.
- P. **Academic Year Review Committee Vice Vice Secretary** means the member of the committee who is responsible for acting as the vice secretary in the absence of the vice secretary.
- Q. **Academic Year Review Committee Vice Vice Vice Chair** means the member of the committee who is responsible for acting as the vice vice chair in the absence of the vice vice chair.
- R. **Academic Year Review Committee Vice Vice Vice Secretary** means the member of the committee who is responsible for acting as the vice vice secretary in the absence of the vice vice secretary.
