**QUALITATIVE DESCRIPTION OR SUMMARY STATEMENT – ANNUAL FOIA
REPORT FY 2015**

DCPS continues to receive a significant number of voluminous requests. During FY 2015, DCPS appointed a new FOIA officer, increased the amount of human capital resources used for processing FOIA requests, and engaged in increased outreach with agency representatives who are responsible for performing FOIA searches. As a result, DCPS experienced a 65% increase in the number of requests processed within statutorily prescribed time limits. In FY 2015, 79% of all FOIA requests were processed within statutorily prescribed time limits
